Label with student's first and last name:

- 1 backpack (no wheels)

All School Supplies

Due to our growth, continued limited storage for year-round supplies, and a desire to steward our funds through bulk-buying better and make all-school supplies a bit easier on our families, Providence will be implementing a flat fee for all-school supplies instead of having families bring the items in multiple times per year. The fee will be **\$80 per student**, due by Friday, August 18th. The fee may be paid on our website under the school store. This fee includes

bathroom supplies, OTC medications available to all students, first aid supplies, cleaning supplies, classroom supplies, paper products, recess supplies, etc.

The 2023-2024 school year will be transitional, and families may purchase supplies in lieu of the supply fee. All items will be due by Friday, August 18th. Those choosing this option will also be asked to replenish all school supplies mid-year. The list does include links to each item for ease of shopping/clarity. The link does not have to be used for purchase. **Please note:** An \$80 supply fee will automatically be charged to your FACTS account if payment or supplies are not received by August 18th.

The following items do not appear on your "to purchase" list:

- Cleaning supplies: PCS is transitioning to an all-natural, medical-grade, EPA-registered cleaner/disinfectant that we will purchase in bulk.
- Paper towels: To help reduce waste, PCS will install single-dispensing paper towel holders in bathrooms and purchase these products in bulk.
- Medications: To ensure items do not expire before the opportunity to use, we will purchase medicine as needed.
- Hand soap: Buying in bulk allows us to purchase refills and be better stewards of supplies.
