



## 2023-2024 Providence Classical Supply List

# *Ninth Grade: Freshmen*

### Individual Student Supplies:

#### Label with student's first and last name:

- 1 backpack (no wheels)
- 1 insulated water bottle that does not sweat
- Locker shelf (no need to label)
- 1 pack 3x5 notecards (100 count) with index box, ziploc or rubberband for storage
- 1 pencil box or pouch with the following placed inside (students need to have these on hand at all times and replace them as necessary. Student may bring a gallon-size Ziploc to keep in homeroom with extra supplies if desired)
  - Colored grading pens
  - 1 fine point Sharpie
  - Highlighters
  - 2 THIN dry-erase markers
  - 2 THICK dry-erase markers
  - 1 PENTEL Hi-Polymer white eraser [Block Eraser Link](#)
  - Pencils and extra lead (if using manual pencils, TICONDEROGA highly recommended) [Ticonderoga Pencils Link](#)

**For the subjects listed below, each student will need either a 1 ½ inch three-ring binder (with pockets) and tab dividers (with pockets) with loose-leaf college-ruled notebook paper *OR* a college-ruled spiral notebook for each subject noted with pockets (Total of: 4 college-ruled / 1 4x4 quad ruled).**

- For English 2:** Section **OR** college-ruled spiral notebook labeled ENGLISH II
- For Christian / Classical Studies [Greek Dramas / Church History]:** ESV Bible (this translation required)
- For Christian / Classical Studies [Greek Dramas / Church History]:** Section **OR** college-ruled spiral notebook labeled CHRISTIAN/CLASSICAL
- For American History I:** Section **OR** college-ruled spiral notebook labeled AMERICAN HISTORY
- For Biology:** Section **OR** college-ruled spiral notebook labeled BIOLOGY
- For Biology:** 1 24-count package CRAYOLA ERASABLE colored pencils
- For Biology:** 1 pair anti-fog lab goggles [Lab Goggle Link](#)
- For Geometry:** 1 transparent ruler
- For Geometry:** 1 transparent protractor
- For Geometry:** 1 compass
- For Geometry:** Graphing calculator (TI-84 or TI-85), labeled with the child's first and last name
- For Geometry:** Section in binder with 4x4 quad ruled graph paper **OR** 2 spiral graph notebooks, 4x4 quad ruled, labeled GEOMETRY

**For Latin:** No additional supplies needed. Students will need a pencil, workbook, looseleaf notebook paper available, a whiteboard marker, and a whiteboard eraser daily. They will also need access to index cards for flashcards.

**For Fine Arts:** All students will need a pencil for All School Chorus. Students will be given fine art elective choices (first choice not guaranteed) within the first 2 weeks of school and may be asked to provide minimal supplies for electives.

**For PE:** Students should ensure they intend to wear their regular uniform OR have dress code-approved PE clothes. Students should have their water bottles available for PE.

## **All School Supplies**

Due to our growth, continued limited storage for year-round supplies, and a desire to steward our funds through bulk-buying better and make all-school supplies a bit easier on our families, Providence will be implementing a flat fee for all-school supplies instead of having families bring the items in multiple times per year. The fee will be **\$80 per student**, due by Friday, August 18th. The fee may be paid on our website under the school store. This fee includes bathroom supplies, OTC medications available to all students, first aid supplies, cleaning supplies, classroom supplies, paper products, recess supplies, etc.

The 2023-2024 school year will be transitional, and families may purchase supplies in lieu of the supply fee. All items will be due by Friday, August 18th. Those choosing this option will also be asked to replenish all school supplies mid-year. The list does include links to each item for ease of shopping/clarity. The link does not have to be used for purchase. **Please note:** An \$80 supply fee will automatically be charged to your FACTS account if payment or supplies are not received by August 18th.

The following items do not appear on your "to purchase" list:

- Cleaning supplies: PCS is transitioning to an all-natural, medical-grade, EPA-registered cleaner/disinfectant that we will purchase in bulk.
- Paper towels: To help reduce waste, PCS will install single-dispensing paper towel holders in bathrooms and purchase these products in bulk.
- Medications: To ensure items do not expire before the opportunity to use, we will purchase medicine as needed.
- Hand soap: Buying in bulk allows us to purchase refills and be better stewards of supplies.
